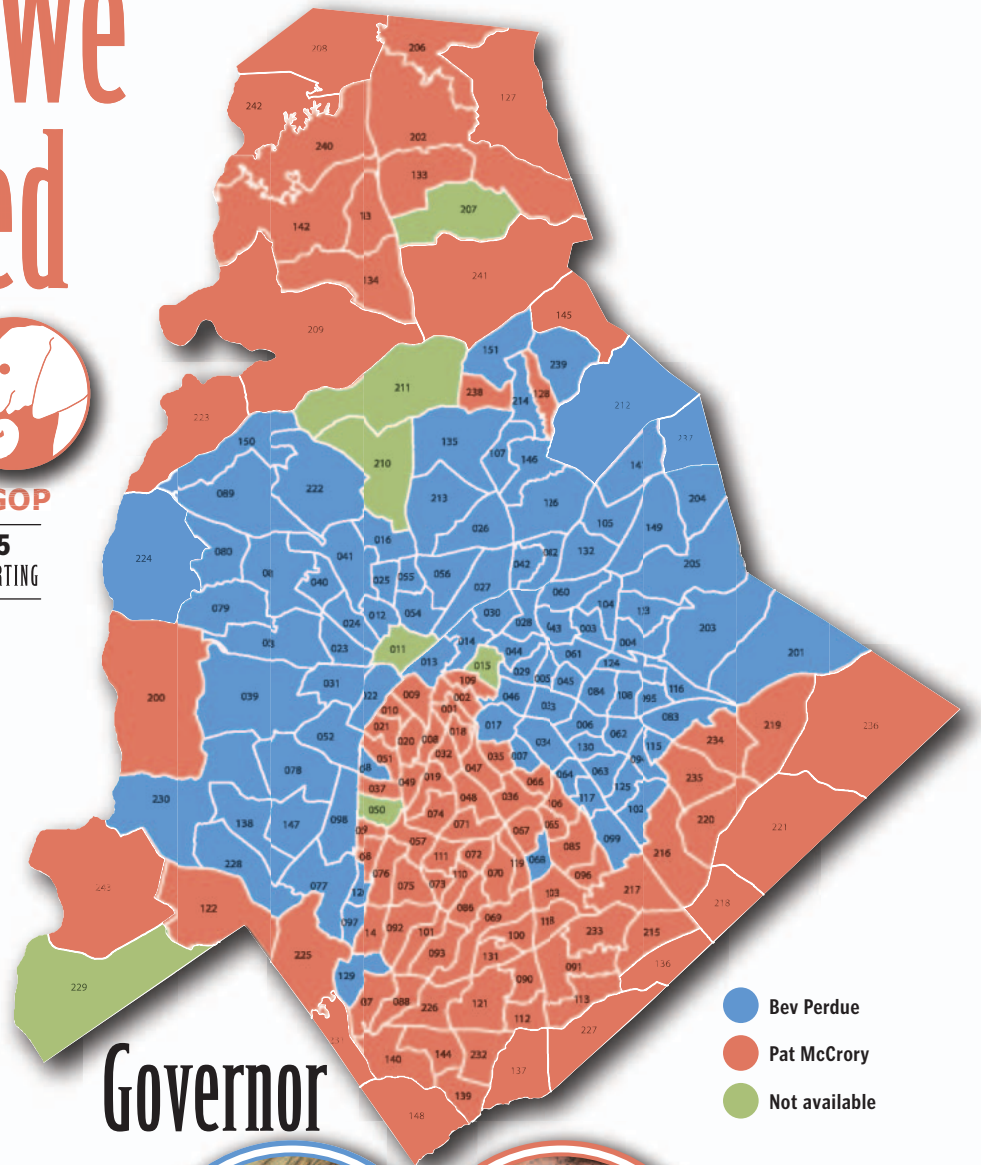

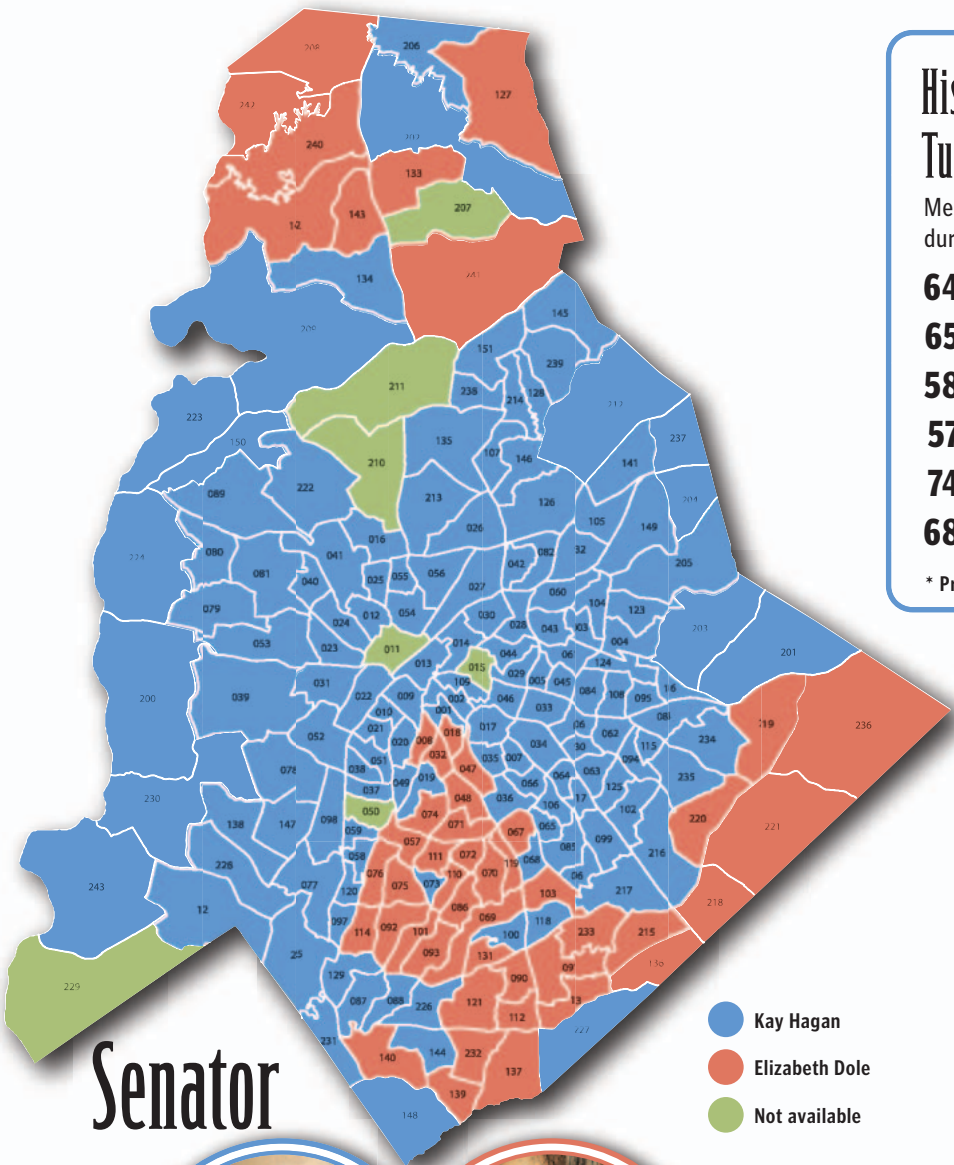

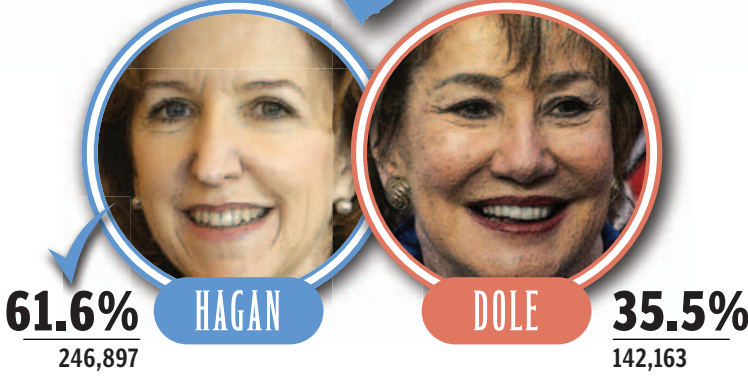

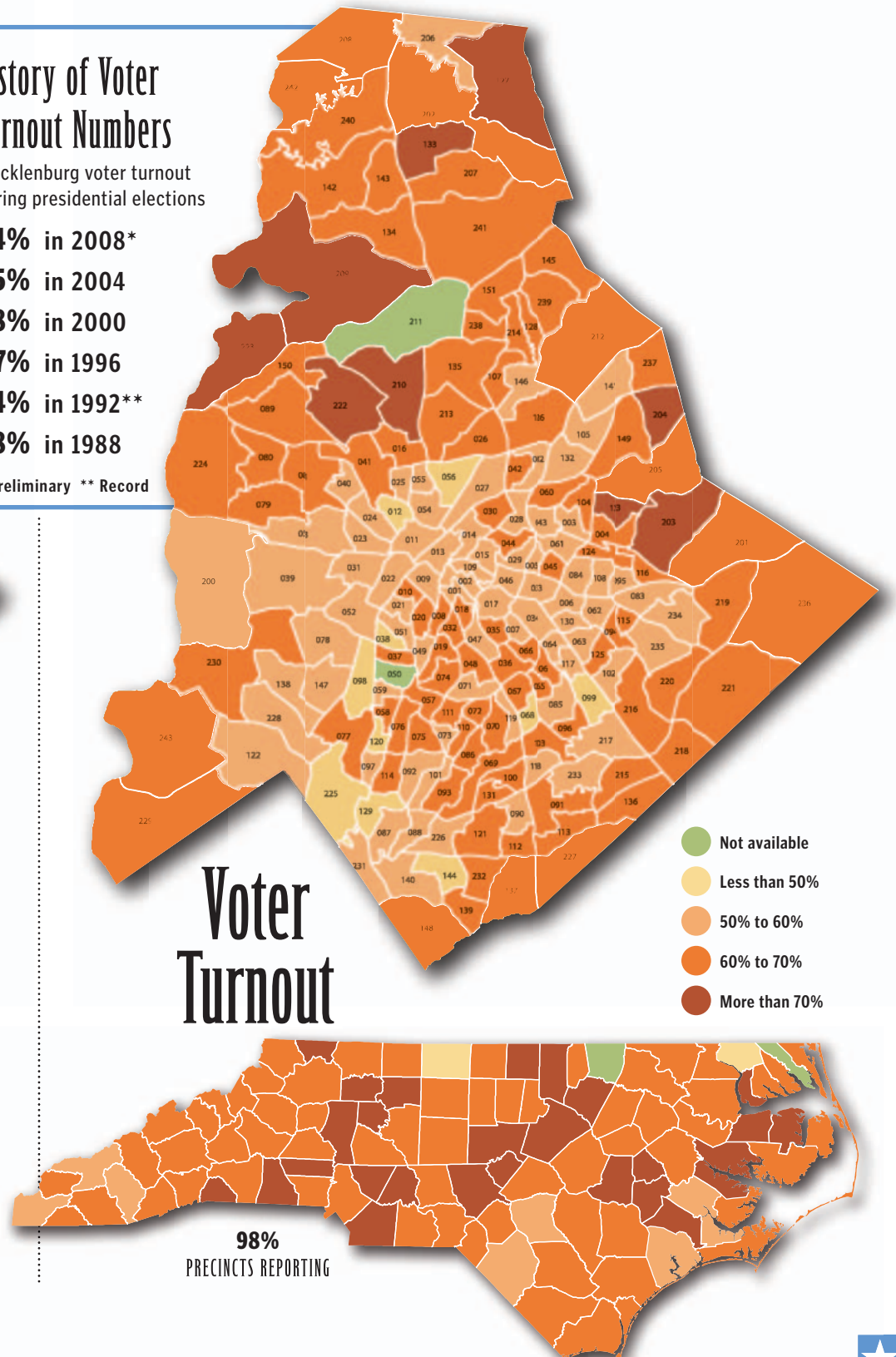


History of Voter Turnout Numbers

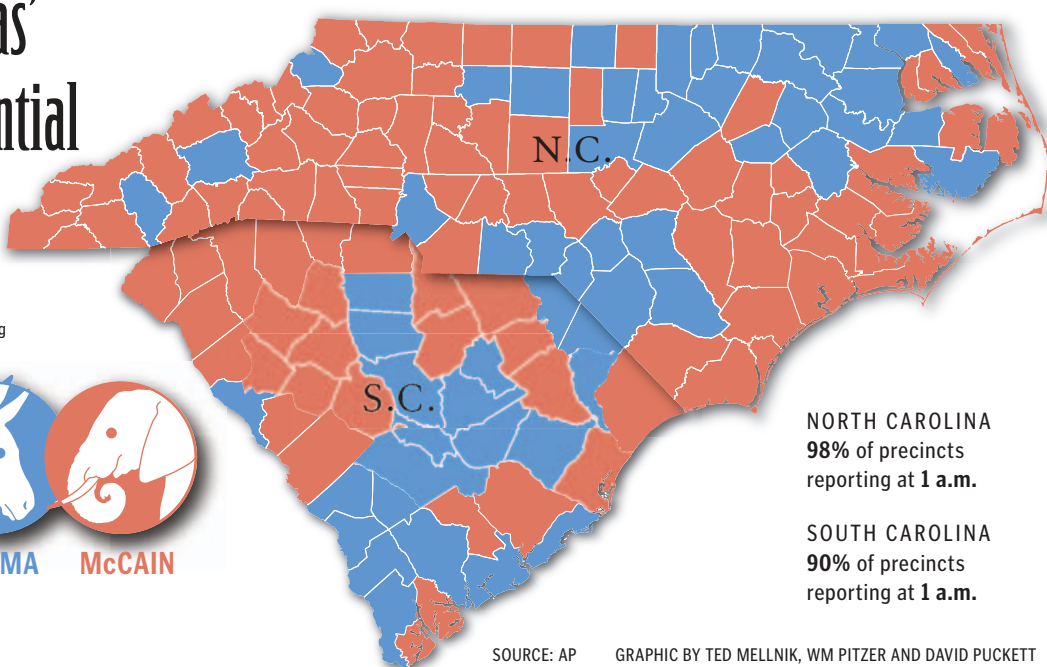
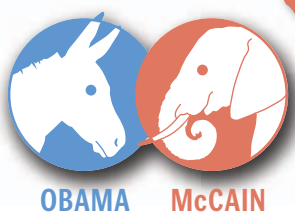
